## 2<sup>nd</sup> year event summary

In early Spring, before  $2^{nd}$  year students schedule their qualifying exams, a 1-hour event is held with one moderator and 4-6 panelists.

## General topics covered during 2<sup>nd</sup> year panel discussion:

- General format of oral qualifying exam
- Timeline of preceding written proposal
- Logistics of talking to your committee ahead of time, getting as much scientific feedback as you can
- Best practices of study group preparations
- Best practices for solo study and writing
- Getting over needing to be in lab
- Practice, practice (and probably practice again)
- Who to invite to your practice quals
- Practice, don't just think about, how to use the white/chalk board
- Prepare yourself for intense pressure: you may get flustered or upset (yes you might cry), and need to figure out ways to deal with it and move on in the moment
- The whole point is to find the limits of your knowledge
- Practice responding to these questions with what you do know that is relevant and based on this what you might speculate
- Maintaining physical and mental health is hard during this time, but super important
- How to deal with guilt of not being in lab
- How to mitigate inevitable stress as is best for you
- How to maintain relationships during this time
- Making an appointment with Counseling and Psychological Services is not an indicator of weakness, it is smart!
- At what point can counseling help? Make a pre-plan with benchmarks that if you lose a certain amount of sleep or weight or start drinking a certain amount, you commit to go.
- Make specific plans to study and make specific plans to relax, too. You can always study on a hike!
